London - four nights – see the Australian War Memorial at Hyde Park, the Royal Horseguards, St Pauls, the Globe Theatre, the Imperial War Museum and the Lord Ashcroft KCMG private VC collection, the Houses of Parliament, Big Ben and Westminster Abbey, the Cabinet War Rooms, Lords Cricket Ground, Greenwich and the Royal Naval College and the Royal Observatory, home of Greenwich Mean Time, and the National Maritime Museum. Plus free time to explore more in London.

Travel by coach & ferry to **Ypres in Belgium for three nights** and see the Ypres Salient including Hellfire Corner, Hill 60, the Australian Tunnellers Memorial, Polygon Wood, Paschendaele, Tyne Cot Cemetery and Menin Gate for the Last Post Ceremony. Then Armentieres, Fromelles, VC Corner, Vimy Ridge and the Arras Tunnels. **Three nights at Arras** to see Beaumont Hamel, Ulster Tower, Theipval and Pozieres where you'll see Gibraltar, The Windmill, Mouquet Farm and the 1st and 2nd Australian Divisional Memorials.

Then to **Villers Bretonneux for the ANZAC DAWN SERVICE** (first held here in 2008), followed by a visit to the Australian National Memorial, Victoria School, Adelaide Cemetery, and Le Hamel.

Then to the Normandy Beaches to **Caen for three nights** and see the Bayeaux Tapestry and Museum, Arromanches, Sword Beach, Mulberry Harbour and Museum, St Laurent US Military Cemetery, Omaha Beach, Pointe Du Hoc, Utah Beach and Museum, St Mer Eglise and the 101st Airborne Memorial. Then to Merville Battery, Pegasus Bridge and Museum, Juno & Gold Beaches, 4th Commando Museum, Le Grande Bunker and the site of Stan Hollis' VC Action.

We travel via Monet's House & Garden at Giverney to **Paris for four nights**. A full days' panoramic sightseeing tour by coach with local guide, includes the Champs Elysees, Arc de Triomphe and Place de la Concorde, entry to the second Level of the Eiffel Tower, Notre Dame Cathedral and the Musee De L'Armee & Napoleons's Tomb. Time to explore Paris on foot (perhaps Sacre Coeur, Montmartre, the Jardin du Luxembourg, San Sulpice Church [The Rose Line], the Pantheon, St Etienne, the Catacombs then cross the Seine to the Isle St Louis, or visit the department stores La Fayette and Printemps and Boulevard Haussmann to shop?) Then we have a half day tour to visit Versailles and the Hall of Mirrors. Afternoon free. A chance to visit the Louvre perhaps, or Musee D'Orsay. Then it's time for home.

Should you wish to stay on in Europe you may like to consider a relaxing **River Cruise** or we can arrange an **add-on for Gallipoli, Turkey** on your way home. We can also assist with a **stopover in Singapore** and a visit to **Changi Museum and the Kranji War Memorial**.
